INSTITUTIONAL ROLES

Full professor in the M-GGR/01 sector, and since November 1st, 2005 carries out his activity at the Department of Humanities of the University of Studies of Macerata.

From 2015 to 2021 He held the director of the Department of Humanities - Languages, Language, Liaison, History, Arts, Philosophy.

He held the office of National Secretary and Vice-President of A.Ge.I. (Association of Italian Geographers).

From 2002 to 2018, he was the President of the Geologic Academy of Treia (MC), a cultural institute (nowadays a Foundation) founded in 1778 promoting studies on agriculture and town and country enhancement.

He is the President of the Deputation of the History of the Nation for the Marches Region.

MAIN RESEARCH INTERESTS

His main interests of research focus on the study of human seats, on the dynamics of town and country relationship, on environmental problems and on issues of cultural geography. Special attention has been paid to the survey of migration flows and to geographical issues linked with the structuring of multicultural society.

He was the coordinator for the Marches Region of the research projects MURST (40% share). He took part in the works of AGEI research groups.

He is the Principal Investigator PRIN 2017: Rethinking urban-rural relations for a sustainable future: case studies of informal food value chains in Central Italy.

ACADEMIC CAREER

Before that he was associate professor at the Faculty of Training Sciences of the University of Studies of Perugia (from November 1st 2002 to October 31st 2005), and researcher at the University of Studies in Urbino (from 1987 to 2002).
