Elena Dai Prà is Associate Professor of Geography at the Department of Humanities of the University of Trento and she is qualified as Full Professor M-GGR/01 – Geography (National Scientific Abilitation). She teaches Historical Geography and General Geography.

She directs the Geo-Cartographic Centre for Study and Documentation (*Centro Geo-Cartografico di Studio e Documentazione*, GeCo), a research centre of the University of Trento and a place for the preservation, fruition and enhancement of cartographic documentation.

She contributes to a number of A-class scientific journals, as referee and member of editorial committees. She is also member of scientific committees (Federation of Scientific Associations for Territorial and Environmental Information – ASITA; Italian Center for Historical and Geographical Studies – CISGE) and boards of directors (Italian Association of Cartography – AIC). Since 2019, she is President of the Trentino section of the Italian Association of Geography Teachers (AIIG).

She has presented as speaker to about 70 seminars and conferences. She has authored or co-authored about 150 publications.
