She has collaborated in the publication of Geography Magazines of national interest: from 1972 to 1982 in the “Notiziario di Geografia Economica”; from 1987 to 1993 in the “Bollettino della Società Geografica Italiana”; since 1995 in the “Annali” Department of “Methods and Models for Economics, Territory and Finance.

For a seven-year period she was a member of the Committee of the Association of Italian Geographers, president of the provincial section of Latina of the Italian Association of Geography Teachers, and member of the Steering Committee of the Society of Geographical Studies.

Since 2010 she has been President of the Society of Geographical Studies.

She is on the teaching body of the MEMOTEF Ph.D. course, with an economic geography syllabus, regarding the Doctoral School of Economics.

She has participated in and presented papers at national and international conferences and congresses, and represents the Society of Geographical Studies of Florence for EUGEO activity.
